Graduates Information

- Graduates **must** arrive at the Sears Centre at **7:15** pm. Enter through Door #11. We encourage families to drive together due to limited parking. <u>Click here</u> to view the Sears Centre Parent and Student Entrance Map.
- Appropriate attire under the gown is required. Jeans, shorts, athletic wear, gym shoes, and flip flops are **not** allowed.
- Graduates must carry their cap and gown into the Sears Centre.
- No alteration of the cap and gown may be made. No jewelry, flowers, or other adornments can be displayed outside the gown. The only adornments permitted are the stoles of the National Honor Society, recognition cords and academic honor medals.
- No personal items, such as cameras, purses, sunglasses, etc. are allowed on the graduation floor. There are NO secure locations to store any items you bring. You may bring your cell phone as long as it is turned off and not visible.

General Information for Parents and Guests

- No tickets are needed for families and guests.
- The graduation ceremony lasts approximately 90 minutes.
- No parking passes are necessary.
- Handicapped parking will be permitted only with a state handicapped parking permit displayed.
- Guests will enter through Door #1, (Main Door). Open to SEHS guests at 7:15 p.m.
- Balloons and noise makers are not allowed inside the Sears Centre.
- At the conclusion of the ceremony, graduates exit out door #4 and guests will exit door #1 & door #3.
