GRADUATION 2021 – FAQ'S

What time should I arrive? Graduates and their family can enter the NOW Arena parking lot beginning at 7:00 a.m.

How long is the Graduation?

Graduation should last approximately 1 hour.

What if we cannot attend Graduation?

The ceremony will be live streamed in the NOW Arena outdoor viewing area.

When will we receive our diploma?

We will have diploma pick-up on Thursday, June 3 at SEHS. We will also be collecting chromebooks, textbooks and any other school related items that need to be turned in.

Can I decorate my cap and/or gown?

No alteration of the cap and gown may be made. No jewelry, flowers, or other adornments can be displayed outside the gown. The only adornments permitted are the stoles of the National Honor Society, recognition cords and academic honor medals.



Grad Pack Pick-Up - Friday, May 21 - 3:00 - 7:00 pm

Graduates will drive through the SEHS parking lot where they will be greeted by music, our STORM mascot, Striker, SEHS staff and administrators. During the drive-thru, graduates will pick up their cap and gown, graduation parking pass, Class of 2021 face mask, graduation name card, and a map with instructions for the graduation ceremony.

Grad Pack includes: cap, gown, mask, parking tag, graduation tickets, and their name card for Graduation. Students are responsible for their grad tickets, replacement tickets are not available.

General Information for Parents/Guardians and Graduates

Tickets/Seating

- Graduation is now in-person at the NOW Arena. **4** tickets for each graduate. Graduates do not need a ticket. Tickets will be handed out during Grad Pack pick-up on Friday, May 21. Students are responsible for their tickets, **replacement tickets** are not available.
- Each ticket will have a seating section number assigned. Guests must sit in the section designated on the ticket to ensure social distancing. Arena seating will be set up in seating PODS, whereby guests will have the ability to sit with their group in a POD and the surrounding seats will be deactivated/covered.

Arrival/Parking

- Graduates and their family can enter the NOW Arena parking lot beginning at 7:00 am.
- One vehicle per graduate, you will receive a parking tag when you pick up your Graduation packet on May 21.
- Graduates *must* be in the car. If you do not have a graduate in your car, you will not be let in the NOW Arena.
- Graduates must show their cap, gown and U-46 ID to enter the NOW arena.
- To avoid congestion and long lines at the entrance of the arena, guests will be given a flyer upon entering the parking lot that will have a designated time slot to exit your vehicle and head to the main entrance. The timed entry only applies to guests, not graduates.
- Graduates should make their way to Door #11 upon arriving on the property. They will then make their way to the floor of the NOW Arena.
- All guests will enter through the main entrance at the NOW Arena.
- Guests without tickets must drive onto the property with a graduate. Non-ticket guests entering the parking lot without a graduate will be turned away. Guests are welcome to bring folding chairs, but pop-up tents and tailgating are not permitted.

Dress Code

- Appropriate attire under the gown is required. Jeans, shorts, athletic wear, gym shoes, and flip flops are not allowed.
- No alteration of the cap and gown may be made. No jewelry, flowers, or other adornments can be displayed outside the gown. The only adornments permitted are the stoles of the National Honor Society, recognition cords and academic honor medals.

Reminders

- Masks are required to be worn the entire time a guest or graduate is inside the NOW arena. Masks will be provided for our graduates and will be given to them in their Grad Pack. Grad Pack pick-up is May 21.
- The ceremony will be one hour in length.
- There will be an outdoor viewing area broadcasting a live feed of the ceremony in the NOW Arena's West Parking Lot. Guests without tickets to attend the ceremony in-person or those who are not comfortable being indoors are welcome to view the ceremony from this area which includes multiple video screens and live audio.
- Clear bag policy: NOW Arena has implemented a clear bag policy which is detailed at nowarena.com. This limits the size of bags entering the area and requires the majority of bags to be clear to streamline the security screening process and avoid unnecessary wait time to enter the venue. Exceptions will be made for medical, family, or child care bags.

<u>ADA</u>

• There will not be wheelchairs available or wheelchair escorts available for guests. If a guest is attending graduation and needs a wheelchair or has mobility issues, they are advised to provide their own wheelchair.

Video Productions will provide video coverage of the SEHS Commencement Ceremony. Grad Images will be photographing all graduates at graduation ceremony.
