DISTRICT FEES AND BUILDING FINES

GRADUATION FAQs

Are tickets required to enter for Graduation?

No, tickets are not required. There is no limit on guests.

Is there a dress code for the graduates?

Appropriate attire under the cap and gown is required. Jeans, shorts, athletic wear, sport shoes, and rubber flip flops are not appropriate. Personal items such as purses and cameras are not allowed. Storage for these items *will not* be available.

Can I decorate my cap and/or gown?

Decorations on the cap will be allowed, although if deemed inappropriate, the cap will be confiscated. There should be no adornments on your gown. The only adornments permitted are the stoles of the National Honor Society, recognition cords and academic honor medals/cords issued by SEHS.

Where is parking? Is there handicap parking?

Attendants will be on duty to assist with parking. Handicap parking is available, only vehicles with an official handicapped tag will be permitted to park in the handicapped area. Any special requests should be directed to Dr. Tucker (steventucker@u-46.org).

How long is the Graduation?

Graduation should last approximately 1.5 hours.

What time should I arrive?

Graduates will enter the NOW Arena at 1:15 pm. and enter Door #11. Graduates will carry their cap and gown into the NOW Arena. Doors open for guests at 1:15 pm. The NOW Arena has implemented a **clear bag policy** which is detailed at nowarea.com.

What door do guests enter at the NOW Arena?

All guests will enter through the main entrance.

When will graduates receive their diploma?

Diploma pick-up is on June 1 from 8:00 am - 11:00 am. for last names beginning with A-L and June 1 from 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm for last names beginning with M-Z. Chromebook, charger, and any other items students have checked out will be collected.

Will the Graduation Ceremony be live streamed?

There will be a link shared prior to Graduation if you would like to view the Graduation virtually.
