

### **Student Services**



\*South Elgin High School is a closed campus. Students will not be permitted to leave during the school day unless they have permission from the attendance office.

#### **Student Dress Expectations:**

Disruptive clothing or appearance occurs when a student's clothing distracts from or interferes with the educational process. For a more specific list of expectations, please refer to the student code of conduct.

#### **Bus Transportation:**

Students will be able to view their bus assignment under the transportation tab in Infinite Campus next week. For specific questions on transportation, please contact the bus company at 847-888-5095.

#### **Student Attendance:**

ABSENCES/TRUANCY: You must attend all classes and study halls unless your absence is authorized by the Dean, the Assistant Principal, or Principal. Please <u>click here</u> to access the traffic pattern that will need to be followed starting Tuesday, August 16 for those students being dropped off, driving to school or being picked up at school.



Please know that there is minimal traffic between 7:00 am – 7:25 am so it would be helpful to arrive early to avoid congestion.


As a reminder, all students being dropped off or driving to school must enter through Door #1 by the flag pole. Bus riders will enter through Door #24 in the back of the building.
