

### **Nurse's Office News**

Attn: Parents, Guardians and Current 11th Grade Students in the Class of 2024

All incoming seniors for the 2023-24 school year are required to provide proof of having received their second dose of the Meningococcal vaccine *prior to the first day of school in August 2023* to be allowed to attend.

The first dose is normally received on or after the student's 11th birthday. The second dose is received at age 16 or older. If you receive annual physicals, there is a fair chance you may have already received this vaccine.

If you do not have a copy of your most recent vaccine records, or if you are not sure if you already received the 2nd dose of the Meningococcal vaccine, please contact your primary care doctor. They may fax it directly to the SE Nurse's Office at 847-888-7613. Please submit proof of having had this vaccine by the first day of school in August. If you have the records, or have gotten the vaccine this year, please send in the proof of vaccine as soon as possible to the SEHS school nurses' office.
