- Our photographers will stay a minimum of 6' away from students and athletes. They will use verbal directions to pose people
- The Photo Zone will be clearly marked and roped off, with photography stations spaced out and have separate entrance and exit points
- Photographers will wear masks or shields.
- Hand sanitizer will be available as supplies permit
- Online ordering will be used to avoid contact with picture forms, camera cards, credit card slips, and pens
- All orders will be direct delivery to your home to reduce touch points

Cafe con Leche Meeting



WHAT GROUP AM I?

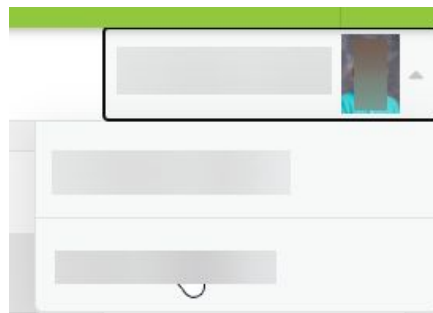
This document provides guidelines for communicating important information to high school families as part of our transition to hybrid instruction starting on January 19, 2021.

- I. Parents can access the parent portal from the U-46 home page at www.u-46.org. If they don't know their username or password, they can use the self-service password reset function.

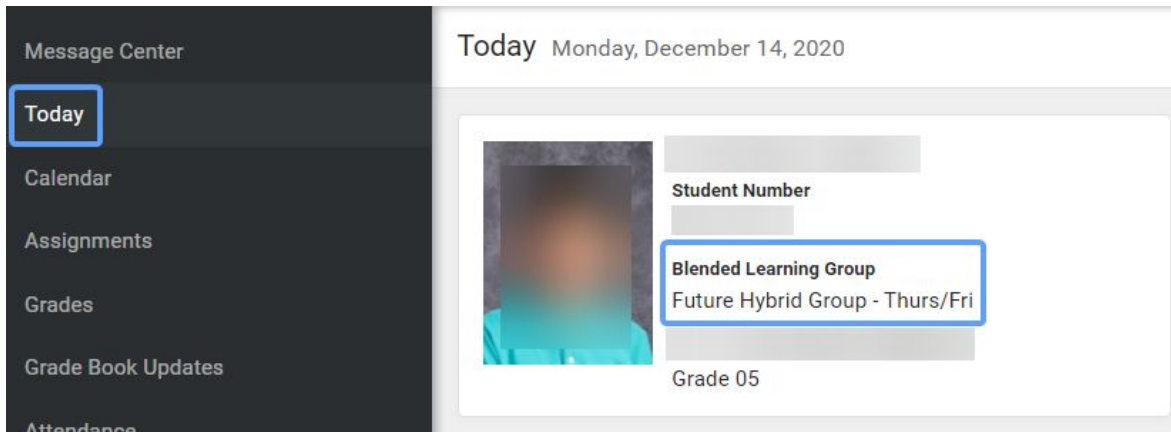

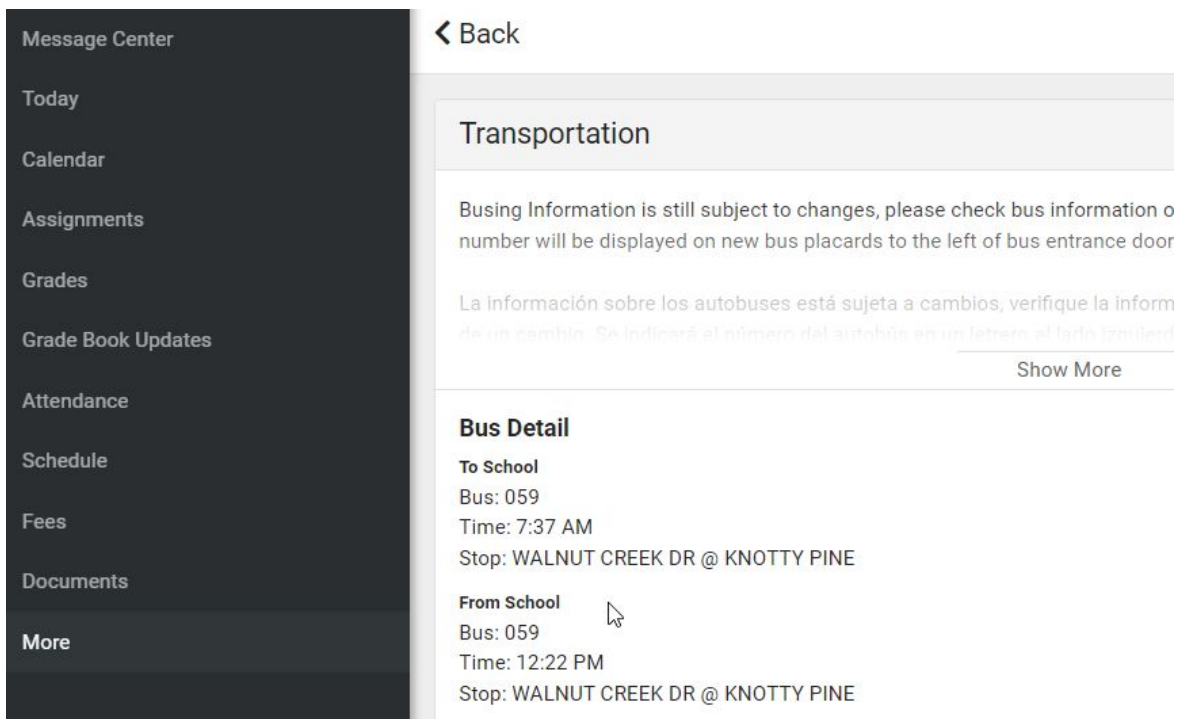
- II. After signing into the IC parent portal, parents can select their student from a dropdown list of all students in the household in the upper-right corner (if there is only one student, IC will take the parent directly to information for that student).



- III. After selecting a student, the first tab shown will be "Today". From here, parents will see whether the student is assigned to Distance Learning or one of our Hybrid Learning groups.



- IV. Finally, parents should also confirm transportation information for their student by clicking “More” and then “Transportation”.



**Please note that due to capacity constraints we will not be able to accommodate requests to switch from Distance Learning to Hybrid Learning.
