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Upcoming Assessment Information

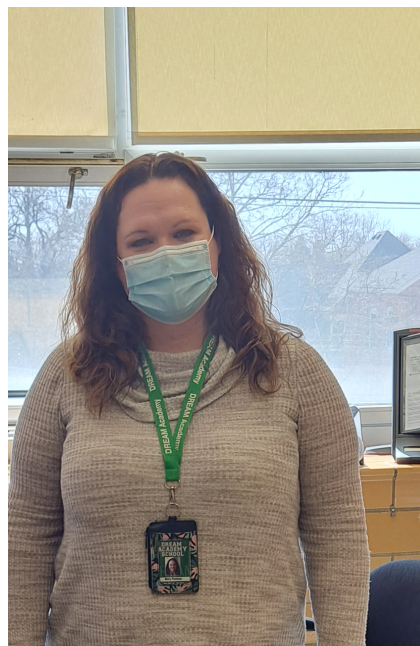
School District U-46 will proceed with a Spring testing window for all State Assessments which includes: ACCESS, IAR, ISA, and SAT. The SAT will be administered on Tuesday, April 13th to 11th grade students. The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) has determined that SAT will not serve as a graduation requirement for seniors. Students in grades 10 and 12 will participate in asynchronous learning on the day SAT is administered. At this time, transportation for students who participate in distance learning will not be provided. However, students have to opportunity to participate in SAT testing. The Illinois Science Assessment has a testing window of March 15th - June 30th. There will be additional details provided in regards to dates and times. We will be administering the ISA to our juniors should take this assessment. According to ISBE, the assessment will be administered in an online format and is aligned to the Illinois Learning Standards for Science incorporating the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS), which were adopted in 2014.
