The Teacher Mentor Program has a series of requirements that will be completed by the Mentor and Mentee throughout the year that include observations of professional practice and reflective, learning focused conversations. These requirements are research based and have been created to support the growth and development of our new teachers.

The Teacher Mentor Program also supports our new teachers with their Professional Growth component of the Teacher Appraisal Plan. Through our quarterly meetings we provide differentiated professional learning focused on Domains 1 and 4 of the Framework for Teaching.

About the Teacher Mentor Program...

The Teacher Mentor Program (TMP) was developed through an interest based bargaining process and remains a collaborative effort between School District U-46 and the Elgin Teacher's Association (ETA) outlined in Addendum C of the Elgin Agreement. Experienced teachers new to the district will receive the support of a mentor for one year while teacher new to the profession will receive two.

The Teacher Mentor Program leverages the expertise of seasoned teachers for the purpose of providing support to new teachers in U-46 through developing trusting relationships, collaborative communities, enhancing professional satisfaction, and offering engaging professional growth and reflection opportunities using the Charlotte Danielson Framework for Teaching designed to positively impact student learning

The Teacher Mentor Program provides a robust induction program based on the Charlotte Danielson Framework for Teaching leading to the retention of high quality teachers and their ongoing development which results in student achievement.

days of your start date. Your request
