

Student Expectations for Chromebook Use

- > Students will be responsible for having a fully charged Chromebook. Charging opportunities will be very limited.
- > Students will protect the device from damage or defacement. Student will not add any personalization to the device. Chromebooks must remain free of any decorative writing, drawing, stickers, paint, tape, or labels that are not the property of District U-46.
- > Student will not disassemble any part of their Chromebook or attempt any repairs. Any repairs needed should be reported to the school as soon as possible.
- > Students will never leave their Chromebooks unattended. Students should know where their device is at all times.
- > Students will save all work on Google Drive. Local files cannot be retrieved if the device is damaged or stolen.
- > Students will not connect personal accounts (such as iTunes) to the device.
- Students will not download or access inappropriate material at school or when taken home.
- > Students will never give their login information to other students.
- > Students must remember that if they give their device to others to use, the student is responsible for any content viewed on the device, any material downloaded and any damage that may occur while it is out of their possession.
