What is the Seal of Biliteracy?

An award issued by the state and placed on the diploma at graduation that indicates proficiency in English and another language.

Students do not have to be enrolled in a World Language class to be eligible.

Languages offered: Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Hebrew, Hindi, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish, and Thai

(Please ask if you are curious about a language not listed.)

How **does a student earn** the Seal?

To be eligible students must:

- Show proficiency in English through SAT with English Language Arts score of 540 or higher.
 - **April 9th, 2019 for current juniors**
- Show proficiency in a language other than English through a district offered national exam.
 - **Offered during school in the fall and the spring.**

How does a student sign-up?

There will be a google doc link available September 4th-7th for students to sign-up. Testing times and rooms will be communicated to students at school.

New Math Intervention

Who is eligible for this intervention and when will it begin?

- Freshmen students who are enrolled in Algebra 1 for the first time.
- This intervention will begin on Tuesday, Sept. 4th.

How are students selected?

- Combination of district data points, teacher recommendation, and classroom performance.
- Students will be reviewed after each summative assessment by the Algebra 1 team to determine who will participate.
- Students will only participate as needed.

What will the intervention look like?

- It will be in addition to the student's math class.
- Combination of APEX tutorials (*not the APEX credit recovery class*) and individualized small group instruction.
- Core instruction and intervention provided by a certified Math teacher.
