Learning Lighthouse Preschool



Learning Lighthouse Preschool offers one session. The session meets Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8:00am-1:00pm. (time and days change from year to year). The cost is \$150.00 per semester and is due at the start of each semester.

The Learning Lighthouse Preschool is taught by the South Elgin High School students who have previously have taken Child Development as a prerequisite for the Childhood Education Learning Lab.

Each of the high school teachers then design lesson plans for the preschool children. They apply concepts that they have previously learned in Child Development as well as the Childhood Education Learning Lab.

During the course of the week your Preschooler will participate in activities that are planned around a weekly theme. They will go through different learning centers such as art, science, media table, alphabet, math, circle time, social studies, and free art. Each activity last for 15 minutes each day. They will each complete all of the centers by the end of the week.

On Thursdays they participate in Super Thursday! This day is designed to give your preschooler the chance to choose the activities in which they would like to participate. They will move freely from center to center, choosing from the activities the high school students have planned for them.

Our Advanced Childhood Education teacher is paired with one of your preschoolers for our kindergarten readiness program. The Advanced teachers will work with your preschoolers two to three days per week to work on skills necessary for success in kindergarten.
