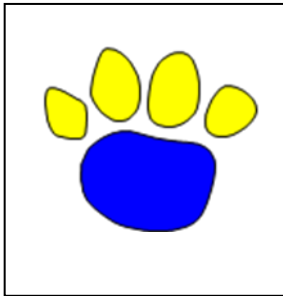

### October PAWS Parent Tip

To get updates on your student's grades, login to Infinite Campus on a computer at <https://campus.u-46.org/campus/u46.js>. (Infinite Campus is also on the district website.) Talk to your student for 3-5 minutes a day about their school day and determine if they have homework, also known as formatives. Create a plan for completing homework/formatives each day. Homework is essential practice for tests also known as summatives. Students must have all formative practice turned in before requesting to retest.
