A. 24-25 SY Calendar Informational Update - Dr. Carpenter Goal: is to always have two (2) School Calendar years approved and published

8 Professional Development Days (status quo)

- 4 Professional Practice Days (PPD)
- 2 District Collaboration Days (DCD)
- 2 School Improvement Planning Days (SIP)

For 24-25, we will continue to utilize four (4) days at the beginning of the year (a mixture of PPD, DCD and SIP). These dates are August 7-9 and August 12th. For 24-25 final designations of Professional Development Days have not been determined. We will look to the Professional Development Committee for feedback in 23-24.

Dr. Carpenter provided this update around the dates. This was an informational update and we will prioritize collecting feedback after the August PD dates next year to determine the best



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structure for support moving forward. One committee member did express a concern at the plan to continue using the four dates at the beginning of the year.

- B. Curriculum/Resource Updates
 - 1. Mariachi Curriculum Jaimie Giraldo
 - a) <u>PD Proposal</u>

Mariachi, while existing as an activity in U-46, is becoming a formalized curriculum that will run alongside orchestra. The PD plan consists of a wide variety of support both to help teachers learn about teaching Mariachi as well as to continue to support the curriculum. The detailed PD proposal is found on page two of the linked document. The committee asked about whether the program would be offered at all schools and Jaimie confirmed that it would be but it is based on registration numbers.

- 2. Information Systems Curriculum Melissa Damewood
 - a) <u>PD Proposal</u>
 - b) <u>Slide Deck</u>

The information systems curriculum is shifting based on the current research and information around the job needs and how we can better incorporate computer skills into other classes so there is better application of skills like coding and increased interest in the course sequence to build on what happens in middle school at the high school level. The specifics of changes are outlined in the slide deck and PD proposal. The PD proposal states, "Due to the scope of this recommendation, implementation will be a three-year process which will allow for a gradual transition for staff and students. Students will be able to complete their original program of study if they begin it in the 2023/2024 academic year and staff will be able to learn the new course curriculum gradually over a three year period."
