# PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE OCTOBER 31, 2024 ASYNCHRONOUS AGENDA

Based on the responses from the google form, here is an AI summary of the work this month:

#### I. Opening

A. Members were asked to confirm their participation via a provided form, to be completed by November 6, 2024.

#### II. Budget Update

- A. Allocated Funds:
  - 1. Registration/Materials: \$30,000
  - 2. Travel: \$15,000
- B. Year-to-Date Spending:
  - 1. \$10,520.24 committed across 18 approved applications.
- C. Applications:
  - 1. Six additional applications were reviewed this month.
- D. Participants confirmed reviewing the budget update, with no major questions raised. Minor feedback was received, such as general clarity requests.

### III. Minutes Approval

A. Last month's minutes were reviewed, and the majority of participants had no questions or concerns.

#### IV. Curriculum Proposal for Elementary Health

- A. The proposal summary was reviewed with the following feedback provided:
- B. The health curriculum as a "specials" subject raised questions about appropriate training for staff.
- C. Support for the initiative to enhance health education was noted.
- D. Concerns included the need for differentiated training and clarity on how existing specialists will adapt.

### V. Scoring Applications

- A. Participants were reminded to review and score applications as needed, following the guidance provided in the agenda.
- B. Training Compliance:
  - Members were encouraged to complete scoring training before signing up to score.
- C. Participation Insights:
  - 1. Several members confirmed scoring the previous week and therefore abstained to allow others the opportunity to contribute.
  - 2. New sign-ups were recorded for this week, with clear indications of which applications were successfully scored.

## VI. Professional Learning Poll

- A. Committee members collected feedback on three key questions about the sufficiency, challenges, and preferences related to professional learning.
- B. Feedback Summary:
- C. Question 1 (Challenges):
  - Most respondents indicated that professional learning was "somewhat challenging," with feedback noting variations in subject-specific needs and time constraints.



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- 1. Example Response: "Somewhat challenging was the most frequent response, especially from educators teaching specialized subjects."
- 2. Example Response: "Teachers felt that while sessions were informative, they often lacked tailored support for classroom implementation."
- D. Question 2 (Sufficiency):

Responses ranged from "somewhat sufficient" to "very sufficient," with specific feedback emphasizing a desire for more frequent and focused sessions.

- 1. Example Response: "Most teachers found the frequency somewhat sufficient but highlighted a need for more targeted topics."
- E. Question 3 (Preferences):

Strong preferences emerged for professional learning sessions held during the school day rather than after hours.

- 1. Example Response: "A majority of educators preferred daytime sessions to ensure better focus and energy for active participation."
- F. Trends Identified:
  - 1. Professional learning is generally appreciated, but more personalization and strategic scheduling would enhance its effectiveness.
  - 2. Educators emphasized the importance of aligning sessions with immediate classroom needs.
