C. Curriculum Presentation - Celia

All presentations and information shared are tentative pending IC review and Board Approval

1. Elementary Integrated

Presented by: Jackie Johnson

- Presented to IC last month
- Goes to school board next month for approval with a tentative approval date in March
- Resources meet ISBE and state mandates
- SS, MME, and Jackie have been working since ETA contract approval last year
- Sixth grade is not in proposal because 6th was put with middle school proposal
- Changes to units: 2, 4, 6 with supports
- Keyboarding program (2-5) - Learning without Tears
- Handwriting program (K-1, cursive in 3) Learning without Tears - all teachers will have online access
- Whole class texts in classroom to support a shared reading experience
- Explicit guidance in SS, Reading and Writing
- Puts in intentional use of students using technology to create their message - directly tied to performance tasks and standards and supported by digital literacy
- Resources: replacing On My Way to English - new: Express
- SS Resources: unused parts of My World/Mi Mundo resources; Story of Our Towns resource (3-4 grade)
- If approved - PD: begin offering in April to specific grade bands
- All resources come with an asynchronous PD option -teachers can use during TCT, on own, at their convenience

2. HS Math

Presented by: Amy Ingente

- Resource option
- Teacher team selected books
- PD plan - days built in and asked for additional days as need it
- Algebra & Geometry - enVision resource (new resource)



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- New lesson structure (inquiry based start to lesson, instruction, independent practice, exit ticket - based on exit ticket resource suggests the practice they need)
- Hard bound student book and consumable workbook
- Teacher supports - many built in - each lesson shows supports for ELLs, struggling, and enrichment
- All book resources are available online
- Student engage with online they get feedback immediately
- More teacher resources online

3. Secondary Informational Literacy

Presented by: Jackie Johnson

- MS/HS
- New curriculum with focus of all getting students in ms and hs into the library, utilizing library services and resources
- Maker space materials and activities in all content areas
- Work done by Jackie and librarians
- Five areas of focus: Individual literacy, media literacy, STEAM, information literacy, digital literacy
- Librarians will work with TCT teams to see where librarians can help lift student's skills in these areas
- Co-teaching partnership
- PD: databases, breakout EDU, destiny platform (digital tech pieces) - getting librarians into these programs to max skills - they already meet in TCT so they will incorporate PD into those times
- Classroom teacher PD: How can I use the tech pieces as well?
- PD will be embedded in the roll out of a new curriculum
