Students, staff, fans invited to show their school spirit at early-morning event

BARTLETT - Bartlett High School will host ABC 7's Morning News and its popular "Friday Flyover" segment on Friday, Oct. 5. The Hawks will be showing off their school spirit in preparation for their home game that evening against Larkin High School.

Bartlett High students, staff, alumni, families and community members are invited to gather at the Activity Complex from 5 a.m. to 7 a.m. on Oct. 5 to be featured on the morning news broadcast. The flyover is scheduled to capture aerial views of the BHS marching band, the football team, students and alumni. Roz Varon, ABC 7's traffic anchor, will be on the ground interviewing staff and students.



The event is extra special since the Hawks played their first varsity football game under the lights of the Activity Complex on Aug. 31. The new stadium also features a press box and permanent bleacher seating for 1,500 fans. It was supported by \$980,000 in corporate and private donations.

"We are ecstatic that Bartlett High School has a stadium thanks to the amazing generosity of our community and District," said BHS Principal Mike Demovsky. "Believe, honor, succeed: We are BHS, and we dream big. What you see today is the dream realized."
