### - The Examiner -Easement offer, expense approved by U-46 board By: Seth HAncock Date: November 20, 2024

The Board of Education in School District U-46 unanimously approved, with a 7-0 vote, of an easement offer from the City of Elgin at its meeting on Monday, Nov. 4.

Also approved by a 7-0 vote was a \$37,520 (education fund) expenditure with the Stepping Stones Group (SSG). Both items were presented and approved that evening.

The easement agreement will see Elgin pay U-46 \$5,500, based on an appraisal conducted over the summer, for an easement that is needed for an upcoming road reconstruction project next summer.

"The reconstruction of Dundee Avenue necessitates approval of a temporary construction easement and a permanent easement for the City of Elgin to proceed with critical infrastructure improvements adjacent to Larsen Middle School, enhancing safety and accessibility for the school community," the proposal stated.

The SSG contract is to provide special education staffing to a private therapeutic school the district uses.

"In order to provide equitable services to bilingual students placed in a private therapeutic day school in alignment with those outlined in the Individualized Education Program, School District U-46 needs to partner with a contract agency to provide the necessary support staff," the proposal stated.

The proposal added: "Similar to U46, our private therapeutic day school partners are also experiencing a staffing shortage, including bilingual support staff. We have a therapeutic day school partner that is willing to accept a bilingual student that needs the language support if U-46 is able to provide a bilingual paraprofessional to support the learning. The Stepping Stones Group LLC is able to provide support staff for us, and this support would extend through the remainder of the 2024-2025 school year and will include an extended school year through the summer of 2025."

### - The Examiner -U-46 expenses ratified as part of consent agenda By: Seth Hancock Date: November 20, 2024

The Board of Education in School District U-46 unanimously approved, of \$437,380 in expenditure proposals under its consent agenda at its Monday, Nov. 4 board meeting.

Included was a three-year proposal costing \$236,468, paid by operations and maintenance funds, with Cintas Fire Protection for state mandated annual inspections of fire alarms. The district's recent contract expired on Jan. 28, 2024.

"As mandated by the Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal, School District U-46 is required to conduct annual inspections of all fire alarm systems in compliance with the National Fire Protection Association Standard, NFPA 72," the proposal states. "This comprehensive process encompasses testing all fire alarm control panels, cleaning and testing each device, and verifying that all signals are accurately transmitted to the designated monitoring stations."

A proposal from Descon Signage for interior graphic installation at the district's welcome center has a price tag of \$107,100 (education fund).

"This project is to create a welcoming and engaging space through the installation of interior graphics at the U46 Welcome Center, which serves as the first stop for many of our district's new families," the proposal stated.

The proposal added: "Currently, the building's interior walls are bare, creating an impersonal and stark environment. The purpose of this project is to transform the building's currently blank and uninviting walls into a welcoming and engaging space that reflects the values and diversity of our district, fostering a positive first impression for families entering our community."

A contract renewal with Wayside Publishing will cost \$54,812 (education fund) to provide additional licenses for its world language curriculum that was approved by the board in 2019.

The proposal stated that the number of students enrolled in Spanish has grown beyond the initial contract regarding the **2019** approval and "those initial licenses are fully expended."

With Tooling U-SME, the board approved of a proposal costing \$39,000 (education fund) for its "learning platform designed to prepare students for careers in the welding and precision manufacturing fields," the proposal states.

Also approved by a 7-0 vote was \$29.7 million in itemized bills.
