The purpose of this proposal is to recommend a purchase of resources to support implementation of the AP US Government and Politics and AP Human Geography curricula.

Rationale

- The AP U.S. Government and Politics curriculum and exam has been revised by College Board.
- The updated curriculum will be fully implemented in fall 2018.
- The resource selected is aligned to the revised AP U.S. Government and Politics curriculum, and will support effective teaching and learning in this course.

Rationale

- The AP Human Geography resources were purchased prior to the 2015 course revision.
- The selected resource provides updated text as well as access to digital resources that are continually updated to reflect geospatial and political map changes.

Process

- Committee members reviewed several text selections during the spring of 2017.
- Committee members met in June 2017 and August 2017 to discuss the merits of each selection.
- Both committees made final selections in August 2017.
