- Chicago Tribune - Swimming classes to return to U-46 high school pools in 2024-25 under proposal awaiting board OK

For the first time since 2019, School District U-46 will be using its high school pools to teach swimming classes. After swimming was dropped as a mandated freshman physical education requirement, the district used the pools for lifeguard training classes and swim teams.

For the first time since 2019, **School District U-46** plans to offer swimming classes at all five of its high schools beyond just lifeguard training.

“The new course being planned for the 2024-2025 school year is designed for beginning to intermediate swimmers,” U-46 Communications and Media Relations Coordinator Tara Burghart said.

The introduction to swimming elective will teach technical skills, aquatic safety and fitness, and aquatic sports.

Open to students in grades 9 through 12 at each of the district's five high schools, the goal is for each high school to have two sections with 24 students each per school for a total of 240 students participating, Burghart said.

Launching the course will cost about \$75,300, according to documents presented at the U-46 School Board meeting Monday.

More than \$55,000 will be spent on purchasing items that will be used for multiple years, including life vests, kickboards, swim fins, water weights, water polo goals and water basketball hoops, documents showed. The bulk of the rest will go to teacher training and development.

District officials opted to replace swimming as a mandated class for all freshmen after the 2018-19 academic year, when a lifeguard certification and leadership course was introduced as one of several new elective physical education options, Burghart said.

Bringing it back is acknowledgment that swimming is not just for lifeguard training but a lifelong, low-impact cardiovascular activity, board members were told. Beyond that, it ensures that those who want to learn to swim have access to a program and it maximizes the use of district facilities during the school day.

The board is expected to vote on the plan Feb. 5.

All five district pools currently are used for lifeguard training classes, after-school IHSA swim teams, the Blue Stars Special Olympics team, and community swimming programs and travel teams, which rent facilities for programs, Burghart said.

Elgin, Larkin and South Elgin high schools have swim teams and **Bartlett and Streamwood high schools** compete together as the “Sabrehawks.” All told, about 130 students are part of district swim teams, Burghart said.

The current district cost to operate all five swimming pools ranges from \$312,000 to \$422,000 per year, she said.

Adding swimming back into the curriculum provides one more election from which students can choose to complete their physical education requirements.

“Freshmen, for instance, can choose between PE classes that focus on functional fitness, strength and performance, team sports officiating and coaching, and walking for wellness,” Burghart said.

One thing students who enroll in the new swimming class won’t need to worry about is wearing a uniform swimsuit. U-46 hasn’t had a district-required swimsuit since at least 1991, she said.

This also means students can choose attire that meets their own comfort level, cultural preferences and other concerns, Burghart said.

With the Oswego co-op team dominating the competition, the only suspense at Saturday's Upstate Eight Conference meet was which team would finish second and who would take the individual all-around second-place title.

For the third year in a row, the Oswego co-op took top honors, scoring 138.5 points. Sam Phillip, an Oswego junior, also pulled off the three-peat, earning her third all-around Upstate Eight first place medal, tallying 35.9 points. The team won all four events.

Glenbard South (125.5) edged out Riverside-Brookfield by one point to finish second.

Ashley Simko, who competes for the **U-46** co-op team, scored 33.3 points to earn second place All-around honors. The U-46 co-op team (120.15) finished fourth.

Oswego first-year coach Mike Borge attributes his team's deep roster for its success. The squad is populated by athletes from both Oswego and Oswego East high schools. Nine gymnasts competed.

"We have so many bodies to fill those slots...we're going to have over half our girls sitting out because we only put up 10 (for both varsity and junior varsity)," said Borge, a former Glenbard South gymnast. "To have that many bodies and really talented kids that want to work hard, it's a great problem to have."

"I'm excited. I was really happy with how things turned out today," Phillip said. "Floor and vault were very good. Bars was OK. I mean, I'm happy with my score, but it didn't go as planned."

Oswego's Ava Sullivan won three events: uneven bars (8.8), balance beam (8.9) and floor exercise (9.4). Phillip took top honors in the vault (9.25).

Glenbard South coach Lee Wood has the reverse problem, but he made the most of his roster.

"This is the first year with the least amount of kids involved in gymnastics, and the highest score we've had in almost 10 to 15 years," Wood said. "I'm really happy with just how they came together. They really enjoyed starting to do better."

Ava Blalock led Glenbard South, finishing fourth (32.1) in the all-around. The sophomore's best showing was in the uneven bars. Her score of 8.2 earned her fifth place,

"Blalock is an amazing gymnast," said Wood. "She picks up things very easy and she's easy to coach." Simko finished second in both the vault and uneven bars, but the Bartlett senior was most pleased with her balance beam routine.

“I was most happy with my beam score. I usually don't compete in beam, so it's a new event for me,” said the senior. “So, my score of 7.85 was pretty good.”

In addition to **Bartlett**, the U-46 co-op team is comprised of gymnasts from **Elgin, Larkin, South Elgin** and **Streamwood high schools**.

Glenbard East's Oliva Broyles (31.85) took fifth place in the all-around. The senior's best showing was on the balance beam where she finished fourth. Glenbard East (115) came in fifth in the team standings.

Riverside-Brookfield's Paige Phelan (32.7) finished third in the all-around.
